



Secure Browsing Self-Audit Checklist

20-Point SSL & HTTPS Awareness Audit

- Do I check for HTTPS before logging in?
- Do I understand what SSL actually does?
- Do I inspect domains carefully?
- Do I avoid ignoring browser certificate warnings?
- Do I know HTTPS does not guarantee honesty?
- Do I avoid blind clicking from SMS/email?
- Do I use bookmarks for sensitive services?
- Is my browser updated?
- Do I avoid risky public Wi-Fi logins?
- Do I understand session theft risk?
- Do I inspect checkout trust signals?
- Do I review website warnings seriously?
- Does my own website have valid SSL?
- Are all pages loading securely?
- Do I know expired certificates hurt trust?
- Do I understand public hotspot risk?
- Do I know padlock ≠ safe business?
- Do I avoid “continue anyway” behaviour?
- Do I review browser address bars habitually?
- Do I practice monthly secure browsing awareness?

Scoring:

17–20 = Strong secure browsing awareness

12–16 = Moderate browsing risk remains

0–11 = High casual exposure online
